**KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

***Staff Supervision***

- assist all medical aspects of staff throughout the week
- Empower staff to be leaders through healthy medical prevention practices
- Assist in Overseeing, addressing, and resolving medical and medication needs of all staff
- Assist with staff medical training and medical discussions
- Create and give camp mental, emotional, social health training
- Oversee, address, and resolve MESH treatment needs for all camp staff

***Camper Supervision***

- Assist in Overseeing, addressing, and resolving medical treatment needs for all camp participants
- Administer camper prescription and OTC medications as prescribed when director delegates task
- Ensure all campers are using healthy medical prevention practices
- Communicate urgent medical situations to medical director and camp director
- Assist in resolving health hazards at camp
- Provide a positive role model for campers



- Help with medical discussions with camp participants
- Support the camper medical check-in, check-out of camp process
- Oversee, address, and resolve MESH treatment needs for all camp participants
- Assist in resolve camper conflicts with camp participants

### ***Camp logistics***

- Track and maintain camp medical supply needs
- Electronically Track all medical treatment given
- Communicate any health hazards to Medical Director and Camp Director
- Attend daily camp debriefs
- Assist with medical team breaks and overnight on call rotation
- Assist in our overnight backpacking trip, acting as the main point of medical care
- Create an inclusive environment to foster growth, learning, and safe adventures
- Adhere to policies and procedures.
- Assist with camper medication check-in, check-out of camp.

### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must be 21+ years old.
- Must pass a background check.
- Experience in medical care.
- experience in group leadership.
- Strong customer service skills.
- enjoys working in an environment of extensive leadership roles.
- Excellent verbal and written communications skills.
- Must be able to work with minimal supervision and be able to learn quickly and adapt easily.
- Able to work Monday-Friday on camp sight. including weekends as needed.
- Able to lift 50 pounds on a frequent basis.
- Ability to walk, stand, and work on feet up to 10 hours a day.
- The ability to move safely over rough and uneven terrain.
- The ability to work in extreme weather.
- Basic manual labor abilities, including an ability and willingness to clean and sanitize facilities with a variety of cleaning agents and chemicals.
