KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Staff Supervision

- Ensure staff are adhering to Rock Climbing and Rappelling policies and procedures
- Empower staff to be leaders through safe Rock Climbing and Rappelling practices
- Oversee, address, and resolve program needs of staff while at the program
- Assist with leading the staff in Rock Climbing & Rappelling training as well as program discussions
- Ensure staff have proper use of program equipment Monitor and address staff safety issues and needs while at the program

Camper Supervision

- Assist with leading camper Rock Climbing & Rappelling trainings through proper program equipment use and safety for campers
- Ensure all campers are using safety prevention practices
- Communicate urgent medical situations to camp director
- Provide a positive role model for campers
- Lead program discussions with camp participants



- Lead campers in an overnight backpacking trip

Camp logistics

- Oversee and assist in the organization, transportation, set up, and take down of the Rock Climbing & Rappelling activities, and backpacking program
- Plan and deliver specialty activities aligned with camp goals.
- Assist in the set up and take down of waterfront and team building recreation programs
- Track and maintain camp rock climbing and rappelling and backpacking supply needs
- Maintain the integrity of rock climbing & rappelling, and backpacking equipment
- Communicate any program hazards to camp director
- Attend daily camp debriefs
- Create an inclusive environment to foster growth, learning, and safe adventures
- Adhere to policies and procedures.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must pass a background check.
- Maintain relevant certifications or experience in specialty areas
- Demonstrate enthusiasm, adaptability, and leadership.
- Prioritize camper safety and group connection.
- Foster teamwork and inclusion in all activities.
- Extensive experience in rock climbing and rappelling.
- Experience in multi-day backpacking trips.
- Strong customer service skills.
- enjoys working in an environment of extensive leadership roles.
- Excellent verbal and written communications skills.
- Must be able to work with minimal supervision and be able to learn quickly and adapt easily.
- Able to work Monday-Friday on camp sight. including weekends as needed.
- Able to lift 50 pounds on a frequent basis.
- Ability to walk, stand, and work on feet up to 10 hours a day.
- The ability to move safely over rough and uneven terrain.
- The ability to work in extreme weather.
- Basic manual labor abilities, including an ability and willingness to clean and sanitize facilities with a variety of cleaning agents and chemicals.
